

## Secure Image Transfer for GP practices and clinics



A quick, secure, and easy-to-use app offering image capture to GPs, clinicians, and consultants using their own devices

In an effort to reduce the volume of hospital outpatient appointments required to triage skin conditions, Cambric collaborated with GPs to develop a simple, fast and secure clinical photography solution for use in primary, secondary and community care settings.

Archie from Cambric is an easy-to-use app that enables healthcare professionals to capture images using their own smartphone, transfer to their local system for attachment to a patient's electronic record or send via other existing clinical systems to specialist services, such as dermatology.

## How does it work?

Archie is comprised of two components – a smartphone app and a PC app.

Simple to install with no complicated setups or configuration, they work together to make image capture and transfer quick, seamless, and secure.

- 1. First, using their smartphone, the GP scans the barcode displayed in the PC's Archie folder to begin a new, secure session.
- 2. The images captured on the smartphone are immediately encrypted then transmitted to the GP's PC and are not stored locally on the smartphone at any time.
- 3. The GP can then attach the images directly to any clinical application using the normal file attachment facility on the PC.
- 4. When the GP taps 'Done' on the smartphone app, all images are immediately and automatically removed from the GP's PC and thereafter only exist within the clinical system.

Images captured by Archie are compressed without degrading image quality or details, reducing the impact on an organisation's file storage capacity.
